Overview	Job holders within this Group Profile will be responsible for providing supervision, knowledge and skills to prisoners in a specialist workshop so they can improve their employment prospects on release with a view to reducing reoffending. The job holder will ensure that all services are provided to a high standard and that security and control is maintained at all times. The jobholder will be able to teach prisoners towards achieving nationally recognised qualifications and may be supported by external organisations such as local colleges.  This job description is not for use by jobholders in basic assembly / packing workshops, instead Production Instructor – Enterprises should be used. However, on an exceptional short term basis jobholders can supervise prisoners in more basic workshops.

	<ul> <li>Induct prisoners to the workshop/area of work and train them in aspects such as health and safety, Control of Substance Hazardous to health (COSHH), machinery and tools usage</li> <li>Provide support for prisoners where required; tailor learning and training requirements to individual needs</li> <li>Set work schedules and manage targets/quality standards, maintaining delivery of contractual arrangements</li> <li>Assess and evaluate skills of prisoners up to national qualification standards</li> <li>Supervise and maintain discipline of prisoners within workshop/area of work, responsible for performance, motivation, discipline, appraisal and development of prisoners</li> <li>Open and complete Assessment Care in Custody and Teamwork (ACCT) forms, Violence Reduction Incident Reports (VRIR) and Security Information Reports (SIRs) when required and contribute to Incentive Earned Privileges (IEP) reports</li> <li>Log attendance and approve prisoner hours worked and wages including recording piece work where appropriate</li> <li>Carry out fabric and tool checks of workshops and maintain security of areas, logging any tool/equipment faults.
