Application Process



You will then need to complete an online Situational Judgement test. This test will check how you judge the effectiveness of actions linked to the behaviours needed to be a trainee forensic psychologist.

Behaviour Based Assessment



If you pass the Behavioural Based assessment your application will be sifted and your qualification evidence will be screened to ensure that you meet the minimum requirements to be a trainee forensic psychologist.

Online Assessment Centre



If you are successful in meeting the minimum required pass mark at OAC you will be added to the merit list for the campaign. We will then appoint candidates to trainee forensic psychology posts in merit order which is defined by the your overall score at OAC.

Your first step is to complete a short, basic application form on-line via the Justice Jobs portal. At this stage you will be prompted to upload evidence that you meet the minimum qualification requirement.

Situational **Judgement Test**



If you pass the Situational Based test you will be asked to complete an online Behaviour Based assessment which will test that you have the strengths and preferences needed to be a trainee forensic psychologist.

Qualification Sift



If you are screened as having the necessary minimum qualifications, you will be invited to the Online Assessment Centre (OAC) to complete the final stage of selection. At the OAC you will need to complete a written assessment, several assessed role plays and a short interview
